Zealana Kauri Worsted
Tī Kōuka Scarf

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MATERIALS:

- Zealana Kauri Worsted (60% Merino, 30% Brushtail Possum; 10% Mulberry Silk 86m 50grams)
- 1 ball of K16 Earth (C2) & ¼ ball of K05 Ponga Fern (C1)
- 1 pair 6mm Knitting Needles
- Darning needle

Sizes: One Size fits most

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Using 6 mm needles cast on 24 sts in C1, K05

Row 1: Knit all sts (24 sts)

Row 2: Knit all sts

Row 3: Knit all sts

Row 4: Purl all sts

Change to C2, K16

Row 1: Knit all sts

Row 2: Purl all sts

Right side facing

These 2 rows are stocking stitch (st-st)

Continue in st-st until work measures 12cm

Row 1: K2 *K2tog, K1* rep from * to * K2

Row 2: Purl 17 sts

Row 3: K8, K2tog, K7

Row 4: P16

Row 5: *K2, P2* rep from * to * to end

Row 6: *K2, P2*

The last 2 rows are 2 x 2 rib

Continue in 2 x 2 rib until rib section measures 58cm, ending with a right side row

Row 1: P16

Row 2: K8, M1, K7

Row 3: P17

Row 4: K2, *M1, K1* rep from * to * K2 (24 sts)

Continue in st-st until section measures 10 cm

Change to C1

Row 1: Knit all sts (24 sts)

Row 2: Purl all sts

Row 3: Purl all sts

Row 4: Purl all sts

Cast of all sts loosley

Back Loop Facing Piece

Cast on 12 sts using 6mm needle

Row 1: K12

Row 2: P16

These 2 rows are stocking stitch (st-st)

Continue in st-st until piece measure 7cm

Cast off

Make up

Attach Back Loop Facing Piece to the back of Scarf at each corner so the scarf can pass through

Knitting Abbreviations:

K = Knit

P = Purl

Sts = Stitches

cm = centimetres

M1 = Make a stitch by knitting into the front and back of the stitch
