Korimako Fingerless Gloves

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MATERIALS:

- Zealana Rimu DK
(Blend of 60% Fine New Zealand Merino Wool and 40% New Zealand Brushtail Possum Fibre; 128m/140y; 50g ball)
- One ball each of shade: R21 Purple Karani & shade: R03 Riverbank
- 3.25mm & 4mm Knitting Needles
- Darning needle

GAUGE: 22sts x 28rows = 10cm on 4mm

FINISHED SIZE: One size fits most.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS:

Right Hand:

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 47 stitches with Shade R03 Riverbank

Rib Pattern:

Row 1: *K1 with R03 Riverbank, P1 with R21 Purple Karani, return yarn to the back of your knitting* repeat to the end of the row.

Row 2: *P1 with R03 Riverbank, return yarn to the front of your knitting, K1 with R21 Purple Karani * repeat to the end of the row.

Work 18 rows of the above 1 x 1 Rib.

Change to 4mm needles.

Work 6 rows Stocking Stitch.**

Shape Thumb:

1st Row: K24, m1, K1, m1, K22. (49 sts)

2nd Row and every following alternative row:

Purl.

3rd Row: K24, m1, K3, m1, K22. (51 sts)

5th Row: K24, m1, K5, m1, K22. (53 sts)

7th Row: K24, m1, K7, m1, K22. (55 sts)

9th Row: K24, m1, K9, m1, K22. (57 sts)

11th Row: K24, m1, K11, m1, K22. (59 sts)

13th Row: K37, cast on 1st, turn,

Next Row: P14 turn,

Work 6 rows with these remaining 14 sts.

Cast off.

Thumb:

***With RS facing, using 4mm needles, re-join yarn and Pick Up and Knit 1 st from the base of the thumb and knit to end of row (47 sts totally).

Work 6 rows more without shaping.

Change to 3.25mm needles and work 6 rows in Rib. Cast off***

Left Hand:

Work exactly as given for Right Hand until ** is reached.

Shape Thumb:

1st Row: K22, m1, K1, m1, K24. (49 sts)

2nd and every following alternative row:

Purl.

3rd Row: K22, m1, K3, m1, K24. (51 sts)

5th Row: K22, m1, K5, m1, K24. (53 sts)

7th Row: K22, m1, K7, m1, K24. (55 sts)

9th Row: K22, m1, K9, m1, K24. (57 sts)

11th Row: K22, m1, K11, m1, K24. (59sts)

Next Row: P14 turn,

Work 6 rows with these remaining 14 sts.

Cast off.

Work from ***to*** as given for Right Hand Glove

TO MAKE UP:

Join all seams.

Knitting Abbreviations:

<i>K</i>	<i>Knit</i>
<i>m1</i>	<i>Make 1 stitch by picking up the loop in between stitches and knit into the back of this loop.</i>
<i>P</i>	<i>Purl</i>
<i>1 x 1 Rib</i>	<i>K 1 stitch, P 1 stitch, repeat.</i>
<i>sts</i>	<i>Stitches</i>
<i>Stocking Stitch</i>	<i>Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row, repeat.</i>
<i>Turn</i>	<i>Turn your needles to work on the other side as you would a new row.</i>
